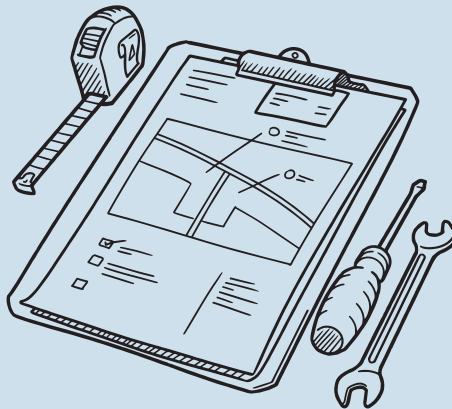

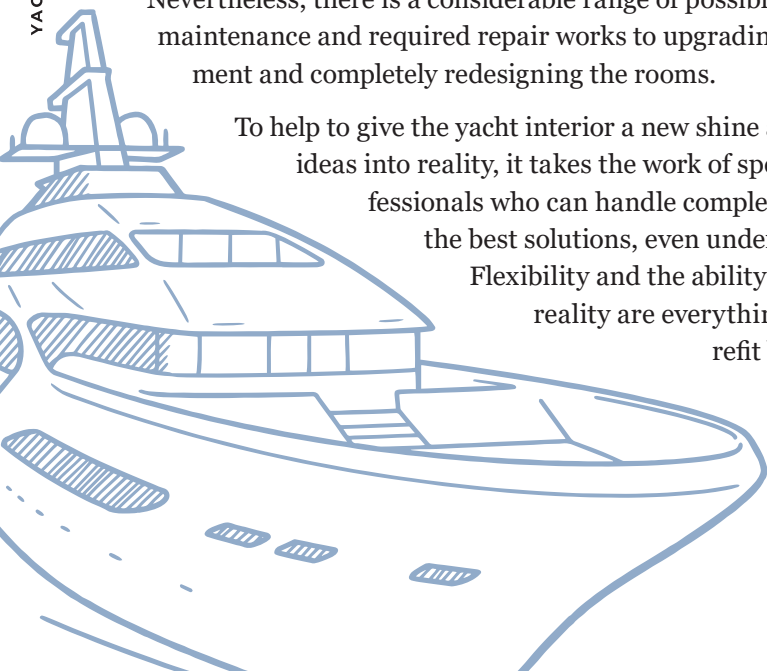

Flexibility and the ability to turn ideas into reality are everything in the fast-moving refit business.



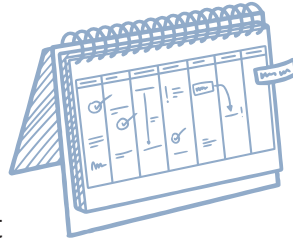
HOW TO CARRY OUT AN INTERIOR REFIT PROJECT SUCCESSFULLY

Careful assessment of the project scope

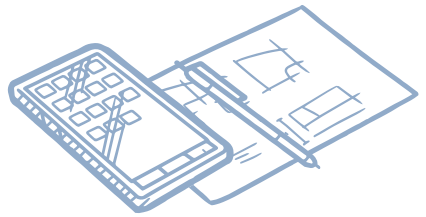

Transparent costing

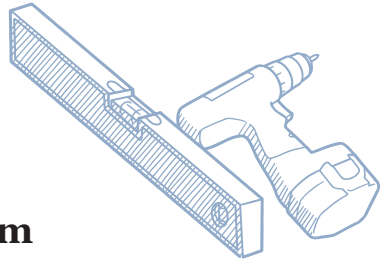

Specialised and flexible team

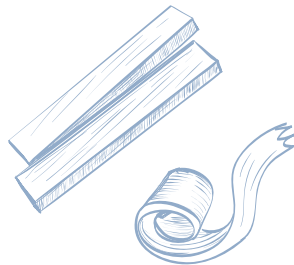
